1. SCOPE OF WORK

- 1.1 Modification of vehicles is envisaged for provision of specialized vehicles (in terms of weather proofing, space management, climate control, dust proofing and providing safe and homogeneous environment) that will enhance the working conditions of communication detachments.
- 1.2 The modifications are required to be carried out on TATA YODHA General Service Vehicles. The modification has to be carried out on the existing structure of the vehicle based on the requirements, as listed out. The modified vehicles are envisaged to provide enhanced operational efficiency by providing facilities for establishing reliable communication on the move. The modified vehicles will be required to be operated in varied terrain with temperatures ranging from extreme cold to hot.
- **1.3** Fabrication of Shelter on TATA YODHA (D+4) variant and placement of Genset with proper grouting and maintaining the CG on TATA YODHA (D+1) variant as per approved drawing and Annexure 1.
- **1.4** Fabrication and Modification of TATA Yodha (D+1) and (D+4) for Mobile Node (Recce Vehicles) as per the specification detailed in technical Bid and Drawings attached and Annexure 2.
- **1.5** 02 Nos Modified Vehicle each (D+1) and (D+4) should be supplied within 60 days from the date of Work Order/Purchase Order for PoC/PDI.
- 1.6 Remaining 38 Numbers of Modified TATA YODHA Vehicles, 19 No (D+1) and 19 No (D+4) will be supplied by Bidder after the successful completion of PoC/PDI of initially modified 02 Vehicles. All the terms and conditions for the remaining 38 vehicles will remain the same as for initially 02 vehicles including SD, Delivery schedule for the remaining 38 Modified Vehicles will be Intimated after approval from the Competent Authority and Mutually agreed by the Bidder.
- **1.7** Extension of work order will be sole discretion of M/s ITI Limited. Competent Authority in ITI Ltd. reserved the right to extension the work order.
- **1.8** List of FIM (Free Issue Material) is attached as Annexure 3.
- **1.9** FIM will be provided by M/s ITI Limited at Bidder Premises.
- **1.10** Bidder shall be responsible for the security and safety of the Vehicles and Items supplied by M/s. ITI Ltd.
- **1.11** Only Non-Chinese items will be accepted.

2. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) / Bid Security Declaration

- **2.1** The bidder will have to deposit earnest money (EMD) @ 2% (Rs. 10,000/-) of the Tender value by mode of provided on e-tendering portal.
- **2.2** The EMD will be refunded within 90 days from the date of opening of tender to unsuccessful bidders whose offers are not accepted.
- 2.3 Bidders registered with MSME need not to submit the EMD. Such firms should produce proof of registration in own name with MSME and NSIC and should provide Bid Security Declaration form.
- 2.4 EMD shall not carry any interest. The EMD will be forfeited, if the bidder withdraws its bid during the period of Tender validity or not willing to accept the terms and conditions of tender/contract. In case of MSME vendors, necessary provision will be invoked for failure to honour the tender conditions as per MSME/NSIC statutory provisions/act.

3. Security Deposit (PBG)

- 3.1 Successful bidder (s) needs to deposit of 3% of work order as an Interest Free Security Deposit in the form of PBG. The Security Deposit amount will have kept till the validation / completion of contract. EMD will be converted as security deposit for successfully bidder. Earnest money will be kept as interest free Security Deposit till successful completion of the contract of the bidder (s) whose tender(s) is / are accepted.
- 3.2 If value of EMD is less than Security Deposit amount (3% of Work Order) then balance amount will be deposited at the time of work order.

4. WARRANTY

- **4.1** The successful bidder shall be given a minimum Two-year warranty from the date of Delivery of Modified Vehicles.
- **4.2** All items should be fully matched with our specifications as mentioned in technical Bid. Mismatch or other equivalent items will not be accepted.
- 4.3 Any defect or deflection happening at the time of Fabrication and modification of this shelter in without any approval from the competent authority. This will be rectified and re-fabrication has done as per terms and technical specifications in free of cost on the immediate basis and after this will be handover to defined address.
- 4.4 Any manufacturing defect during the warranty period (min two years) shall be

replaced/corrected by the vendor free of cost immediately at customer premises (PAN INDIA).

5. PAYMENT TERMS

- **5.1** The vendor will submit the tax invoice for the fabricated shelter as per drawing.
- **5.2** The payment will be made within 60 days after receiving the Tax Invoice with GST Number as mentioned in the billing address.
- **5.3** After the successful Inspection of Vehicles by M/s ITI Ltd. Technical team, 60% of the bill value will be processed. The remaining 40% of the bill value will be processed after PoC/PDI.
- 5.4 The final bill shall be submitted by the Bidder after the issuance of completion certificate by the Engineer in Charge, which will be issued after satisfactory performance of one trial/operational activity. No further claims shall be made by the Bidder after submission of the final bill and these shall be deemed to have been waived and extinguished. Payment of the bill shall be made within the 60 days; the period being reckoned from the date of receipt of the bill by the Engineer-In-Charge.

6. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

- **6.1** Bidders/Firms that fulfill the requirements mentioned in this tender document shall be eligible to apply.
- **6.2** On the tender opening date, the bidders can log-in and see the bid opening process.
- **6.3** Bidder can upload documents in the form of PDF format only.
- **6.4** Bidder must quote rate items separately per format given in Financial Bid.
- **6.5** If any cell is left blank and no rate is quoted by the bidder, the Rate of such items shall be treated as rupees "0" (ZERO)
- 6.6 The eligibility documents shall be opened first for technical bids on the due date and time as mentioned above. Financial evaluation of Bidders/Firms who qualified in technical evaluation will be opened on the later date.
- **6.7** ITI Limited reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason thereof.
- **6.8** Quoted Rate validity shall be for two years.

- **6.9** The rates will be submitted as per the financial bid (**Annexure-10**). Financial bid in another format shall be liable to be rejected.
- **6.10** In case, if the bidders do not submit any tender relevant document as mentioned in Technical Bid, his bid will be outright rejected and the bid will not be considered for further evaluation.
- **6.11** As the items will use in Defense Project therefore only Non-Chinese items will be accepted. Bidder shall also submit the undertaking for supply of Non-Chinese items (Undertaking format is given in **Annexure-3** in tender document).
- **6.12 GOVERNMENT LAW: -** All suits shall be instituted in a court of competent jurisdiction at Delhi and in case of arbitration; the Indian Arbitration Conciliation Act 1996 is applicable.
- **6.13** Ethical bond will be considered for overall project. Please check it before submitting the tender/ or uploading the supporting documents.
- 6.14 Competent Authority in ITI Ltd. has the right to accept or reject any or all tenders without assign any reason. Tender receipt after due date will not be considered.

7. PENALTY TERMS

In the event of the Bidder fails to provide the delivery as per given timelines/schedules, The ITI Limited, as his discretion, withholds any payment until the completion of the delivery. Further, the ITI Limited may also deduct LD @ 0.5% of the contract value for every week of delay for undelivered portion of the order, subject to maximum value of LD being not higher than 5% of the contract value.

In the case, LD reaches up to its maximum value as defined hereinabove. The ITI Limited reserves the right to terminate the contract.

Further, in case of delay in the delivery and ITI is of the opinion that such delay of delivery impacts entire project then ITI holds the right to:

- a. Arrange the similar material/work from any other agency/ third party and the difference cost of such arrangement will be barred by the bidder.
- b. Reserves the right to terminate the contract with the bidder.

2. Whereas the Bidder is a private company/public company/partnership/ registered agency, constituted in accordance with the relevant law in the matter and the Principal is a Public Sector Undertaking under Government of India.

Objectives:

- **4.2**The Principal will, during the pre-contract stage, treat all Bidders alike, and will provide to all Bidders the same information and will not provide any such information to any particular Bidder which could afford an advantage to that particular bidder in comparison to other bidders. All the officials of the Principal will report to the Management any attempted or completed breaches of the above commitments as well as any substantial suspicion of such a breach. No employee of the Principal, personally or through family members, will in connection with the tender for, or the execution of contract, demand, take a promise for or accept, for self or third person, any Material benefit which the person is not legally entitled to.
- **4.3** In case any such preceding misconduct on the part of such official (s) is reported by the Bidder to the Principal, with full and verifiable facts and the same is prima facie found to be correct by the Principal, necessary disciplinary proceedings, or any other action as deemed fit, including criminal proceedings may be initiated by the Principal and such a person shall be debarred from further dealings related to the contract process. In such a case while an enquiry is being conducted by the Principal the proceedings under the contract would not be stalled.

Commitments of Bidder:

- **5.**The Bidder commits himself to take all measures necessary to prevent corrupt practices, unfair means and illegal activities during any stage of his bid or during any precontract or post-contract stage in order to secure the contract or in furtherance to secure it and in particular commits himself to the following:
- **5.1**The Bidder will not offer, directly or through intermediaries, any bribe, consideration, gift, reward, favour, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the principal, connected directly or indirectly with bidding process, or to any person, organization or third party related to the contract in exchange for any advantage in the bidding, evaluation, contracting and implementation of the Contract.
- **5.2** The Bidder further undertakes that he has not given, offered or promised to give, directly or indirectly any bribe, gift, consideration, reward, favour, any material or immaterial benefit or other advantage, commission, fees, brokerage or inducement to any official of the Principal or otherwise in procuring the Contract or forbearing to do or having

done any act in relation to the obtaining or execution of the Contract or any other Contract with the Principal for showing or forbearing to show favour or disfavour to any person in relation to the Contract or any other Contract with respect to the Principal's Organization.

- **5.3**The Bidder will not collude with other parties interested in the contract to impair the transparency, fairness and progress of the bidding process, bid evaluation, contracting and implementation of the contract.
- **5.4** The Bidder will not accept any advantage in exchange for any corrupt practice, unfair means and illegal activities.
- **5.5** The Bidder confirms and declares to the Principal that it has not engaged any individual or firm or company whether Indian or foreign to intercede, facilitate or in any way to recommend to the Principal, or any of its functionaries, whether officially or unofficially to the award of the contract to the Bidder; nor has any amount been paid, promised or intended to be paid to any such individual, firm or Company in respect of any such intercession, facilitation or recommendation.
- **5.6**The Bidder, either while presenting the bid or during pre-contract negotiations or before signing the contract, shall disclose any payments he has made, is committed to or intends to make to officials of the Principal or their family members, agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the contract and the details of services agreed upon f or such payments.
- **5.7** The Bidder shall not use improperly, for purposes of competition or personal gain, or pass on to others, any information provided by the Principal as part of the business relationship, regarding plans, technical proposals and business details; including information contained in any electronic data carrier. The Bidder also undertakes to exercise due and adequate care lest any such information is divulged.
- **5.8** The Bidder commits to refrain from giving any complaint directly or through any other manner without supporting it with full and verifiable facts.
- **5.9**The Bidder shall not instigate or cause to instigate any third person to commit any of the actions mentioned above. If the Bidder or any employee of the Bidder or any person acting on behalf of the Bidder, either directly or indirectly, is closely related to any of the officers of the principal, or alternatively, if any close relative of an officer of the Principal has financial interest/stake in the Bidder's firm, the same shall be disclosed by the Bidder at the time of filing of tender.
- **6.0.** Any failure to disclose the interest involved shall entitle the Principal to rescind the contract without payment of any compensation to the Bidder.
- **6.1** The term 'close relative' for this purpose would mean spouse whether residing with

the Principal's employee or not, but not include a spouse separated from the Principal's employee by a decree or order of a competent court; son or daughter or step son or step daughter and wholly dependent upon Principal's employee, but does not include a child or step child who is no longer in any way dependent upon the Principal's employee or of whose custody the Principal's employee has been deprived of by or under any law; any other person related, whether by blood or marriage, to the Principal's employee or to the Principal's employee's wife or husband and wholly dependent upon Principal's employee.

6.2 The Bidder shall not lend to or borrow any money from or enter into any monetary dealings or transactions, directly or indirectly, with any employee of the Principal, and if he does so, the Principal shall be entitled forthwith to rescind the contract and all other contracts with the Bidder. The Bidder shall be liable to pay compensation for any loss or damage to the principal resulting from such rescission and the Principal shall be entitled to deduct the amount so payable from the money(s) due to the Bidder.

Validity: The validity of this Integrity Pact shall be from date of its signing and extend till the complete execution of the contract to the satisfaction of both the Bidder and the principal.
