Standard score of ratio for full marks is 2:1 or above	It is respectfully submitted that a current ratio of 2.00, though indicative of strong short-term liquidity, is significantly above the norm followed by both: Infrastructure industry practice, and Banking and project finance institutions, including norms laid out by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) and major Public Sector Banks. In fact, the RBI's Resolution Framework mandates a minimum current ratio of 1.00 for project loan accounts, even in stress or restructuring scenarios. Furthermore, as per traditional working capital assessment methods (such as Tandon Committee norms), a current ratio of 1.33 is widely accepted by banks for approving and monitoring working capital facilities. Sector Characteristics The infrastructure sector is inherently working-capital intensive, with substantial receivables from government and quasi-government clients. As such, companies tend to operate with a current ratio ranging between 1.20 and 1.50, which is considered financially healthy and bankable. In view of the above, we humbly request that the current ratio requirement in the EOI document be rationalized from 2.00 to 1.50, which is aligned with banking standards, and reflects the financial structure of operationally sound infrastructure companies.
