Rs 23 Cr				Experience criteria disproportionate to tender value The experience requirements stated in the tender document seem excessively high when compared to the estimated value of the work. The document specifies that the bidder must have the following experience zone-1: One single PO of Rs.: 48.82 Cr or Two PO of Rs. 30.52 Cr each or Three PO of Rs. 24.41 Cr each. These experience criteria appears to be over 200% to 275% higher than the implied total value of Zone-1 based on the EMD calculation. In line with the CPWD manual (Cl. 7.2.3), the experience creiteria should be commensurate with the tender value to maintain fairness and avoid unnecessarily restrictive conditions for potential bidders. We kindly request clarification on the rationale behind these high thresholds. We kindly request the following clarification on the rationale behind setting the experience requirements at levels exceeding the tendered value.			EMD has been calculated based on ITI guidelines.
